1) Purpose

North Sea Midstream Partners Limited is the parent company of the NSMP group ("NSMP"). This statement is made pursuant to section 54(1) of the Modern Slavery Act 2015 (the "Act") and constitutes NSMP's slavery and human trafficking statement for the year ending 31 December 2019.

2) Slavery & Human Trafficking Statement

NSMP provides gas transportation and processing services across the United Kingdom and contracts with businesses in the United Kingdom and Europe for the supply of goods and services.

NSMP realises that contracting with companies, whether based in the United Kingdom or other jurisdictions, potentially gives rise to the risk of slavery or human trafficking issues.

NSMP is committed to driving out acts of modern day slavery, if discovered, from within its business or supply chain. NSMP acknowledges responsibility under the Act and will ensure transparency within its organisation and with its suppliers.

Accordingly, NSMP will not:

- Knowingly be involved in slavery or human trafficking in any of the services it provides
- Accept any goods or services from suppliers that are involved in slavery or human trafficking, or
- Deal with any business that is involved in slavery or human trafficking
